Husam in the dark over son's arrest in drug bust

Husam in the dark over son's arrest in drug bust

KOTA BARU: More than 30 hours had passed since Datuk Husam Musa was informed that a group of men had taken his son away.

But the Salor assemblyman still had not received official word from the police that his son had been arrested to help investigations into a drug-related case.

"I was not even aware that the police had taken my son to court to obtain a remand order the next day (yesterday morning).

"I only found out after a screenshot of the news published in a portal was forwarded to me.

"I do not know where they are holding my son," the Parti Amanah Negara vice-president said last night. Husam's son Ahmad Syafi, 29,

Husam's son Anmad Syafi, 29, was remanded for four days to assist in investigations into the discovery of 200 pills, believed to be methamphetamine, in his pocket.

Kota Baru OCPD Asst Comm Ismail Mat Sidik confirmed that they obtained the remand order yesterday.

It was reported that the 29-yearold son of an assemblyman was arrested after being caught with 200 methamphetamine pills at 3.30pm on Saturday.

Husam said he would release a full statement after meeting his son.
