BOY HELD IN ANTI-DRUGS OP

GEORGE TOWN: A Year Six pupil was among 100 people detained in a three-day operation conducted by the Penang National Anti-Drugs Agency, beginning last Friday. The suspects also included 10 other pupils and three women, aged between 12 and 72. They tested positive for drugs in the operation, "Ops Perdana". State anti-drugs agency enforcement chief Nasruddin Abdul Rahman said two of the suspects, who had syabu and heroin and were believed to be drug pushers, were handed over to the police. Meanwhile in Butterworth, police detained 18 motorcyclists who were high on drugs, and issued 334 summonses for various traffic offences during an operation. – Bernama
