Couple on drug charges out on bail

Couple on drug charges out on bail

KUALA LUMPUR — The couple from whose apartment the Dutch teen model allegedly fell to her death were both allowed bail earlier this week on their two drug charges.

A magistrate's court granted American Alexander William Johnson, 44, bail of RM4,500 on Monday after he claimed trial.

His Kazakh wife, Lunara Almazkyzy, 30, was allowed bail of RM2,500 in two sureties after she pleaded guilty to her charge.

Both were charged under Section 15(1)

(a) of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952 with the consumption of drugs. They are liable to be jailed for two years, fined not more than RM5,000 or both upon conviction.

A source told *Malay Mail* the court allowed bail after immigration checks found their passports and visas valid.

"The magistrate allowed bail for Johnson in two sureties, and set Jan 8 as the next court date," the source said, adding the case was awaiting results of his urine tests.

"The next court date for Almazkyzy is Jan 19, pending lab results of her urine

samples," the source said.

The court previously withheld bail pending verification of the validity of their travel documents.

The couple were said to be the last people to be seen with Ivana Esther Robert Smit, the 18-year-old Dutch model found dead on Dec 7.

The couple were supposedly out partying with the model the day before her naked body was found, after allegedly falling 14 floors from their condominium unit in Dang Wangi.
