4 held, RM16,000 worth of drugs seized

3-DAY OPERATION

4 held, RM16,000 worth of drugs seized

PASIR MAS: Police have arrested four men for having drugs worth RM16,000 in four raids here and in Rantau Panjang.

The arrests and seizures were part of a three-day operation held in collaboration with the General Operations Force (GOF), which ended on Saturday.

District police chief Assistant Commissioner Abdullah Mohammad Piah said about RM40,000

in cash and two stolen cars were also confiscated.

In the first raid in Kampung Gual Tok Deh Barat near Rantau Panjang on Thursday, the team detained a 30-year-old man and seized 305 bottles of cough mixture, believed to contain codeine.

“The cough mixture (is believed to have been intended as an ingredient) for ketum water.

“The suspect tested positive

for drugs,” Abdullah said.

He said during raids on Friday and Saturday, police detained three other men, aged between 20 and 40, in Kampung Landar, Kampung Kubang Batang and Kampung Bendang Pauh, all in Pasir Mas.

“Police seized 6g of heroin and 307 pills. The suspects have been remanded to assist police investigations into the cases.”
