Actor pleads not guilty to drug abuse charge

Actor pleads not guilty to drug abuse charge

PETALING JAYA: Actor and director Datuk Farid Kamil has pleaded not guilty to drug abuse at the magistrate's court here.

Farid was charged with abusing the drug THC (tetrahydrocannabinol, the primary psychoactive compound found in ganja) on Jan 11.

Magistrate Nor Ariffin Hisham allowed bail of RM3,000 with one guarantor and asked Farid to surrender his passport.

He was charged under Section 15(1)(A) of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1992, which carries a maximum sentence of two years' jail, a RM5,000 fine or both.
