

## Inspector jailed six years for bribery

#### INSPECTOR JAILED SIX YEARS FOR BRIBERY

**KUALA TERENGGANU:** An inspector will spend a total of six years in prison after he was found guilty of soliciting and receiving bribes to cover up a drug offence. Mohd Izzwan Jamalud Din, 35, was convicted of violating Section 17(a) and Section 16(a)B of the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission Act 2009 for receiving and soliciting bribes while serving with the Hulu Terengganu district police headquarters' Narcotics Criminal Investigations Department in August 2015. Judge Mohamad Haldar Abd Aziz sentenced the police officer to three years in prison for accepting bribes and an additional three years for soliciting.
