Trump seeks death for drug dealers

WASHINGTON: US President Donald Trump is set to present his plan to combat an opioid abuse epidemic, including seeking the death penalty against drug traffickers.

The Department of Justice "will seek the death penalty against drug traffickers where appropriate under current law," a White House official indicated on Sunday whilst outlining the plan's main points. The official did not offer greater detail on how the death penalty could be invoked against drug dealers without amending statutes. Trump was due to unveil his plan in a speech yesterday in Manchester, New Hampshire, a state hard hit by the crisis.
