Cops seize ganja worth RM3.4mil

Cops seize ganja worth RM3.4mil

KUALA LUMPUR: Various drug busts by narcotics police have cut off supply to 22 million addicts nationwide, including in the Klang Valley, says Comm Datuk Seri Mohmad Salleh.

"Since January, some 1.14 tonnes of ganja worth RM3.4mil had been seized," Bukit Aman Narcotics Crime Investigation Department (NCID) director said.

"These successes against traffickers are due to the continuous efforts by the NCID and Sting (Special Tactical Intelligence Narcotics Group)," he told a press conference at the Gombak police district headquarters yesterday.

He also attributed the success to close public cooperation, saying "the war against drugs cannot be won by the authorities alone".

In the latest raid, he said police seized ganja weighing 175.61kg and arrested two men at the Rawang toll plaza before dawn on Tuesday.
