DPM: Umno man's drug arrest regrettable

DPM: Umno man's drug arrest regrettable

KUALA KRAI: Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi has expressed regret over the arrest of an Umno divi-sion chief who allegedly tested pos-itive for drugs during a raid on a karaoke centre.

He said it was something that should not have happened, and he would talk to party president Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak about any action to be taken against the sus-

pect.
"We will bring it up during a meeting with the Prime Minister on the possible action that can be taken based on the party constitu-tion and laws," he told reporters after attending a meet-and-greet programme with the people here

yesterday.

Dr Ahmad Zahid said the incident would affect the coalition's performance as a whole in the constituency even though it has been allocated to the MCA.

"I believe that it will have an impact on us but we will make every effort to minimise it so it will not reduce the trust of the people towards the whole organisation in that area," he said.
