Thai police finger M'sian as drug lord

Identity of syndicate boss gleaned from suspects arrested with 700kg of Ice

BANGKOK: A Malaysian man whom Thai police calls "Aj" is believed to be a drug lord and responsible for trying to smuggle 700kg "Ice" (crystal methamphetamine) into Malaysia on March 28. "He (Aj) is the man behind the 700kg of Ice." Narcotics Suppression Bureau (NSB) head Lt-Gen Sommai Kongvisaisuk said here recently. The huge quantity of drugs seized, valued at over Bt500mil (RM64mil), had surprised the NSB.

AJ was identified through intelligence as well as "information" extracted from two Malaysian suspects arrested during the operation in Hatyai last month.

The men, aged 34 and 49, from two northern Malaysian states, were nabbed by undercover officers while unloading the drugs from a lorry into a rented house in the southern Thai border town.

A Thai man who drove the lorry was also detained, while an armed
