

17-year-old girl believed to be 'high' on drugs brought to police station

MIRI: A 17 year-old girl believed to be under the influence of drug was found wandering suspiciously within the Holiday Park residential area here on Friday.

In the 8pm incident, several residents spotted the girl shouting and uttering some words at unseen objects, while holding a plastic bag.

"She even took off her pants and urinated in the middle of the road," said one of the residents, who wished to be known as Wong, 40.

"She was even spotted inhaling something inside the plastic bag she was holding," he added.

Worried for her safety, the residents immediately called up the police after they

failed to coax her to go home.

The incident attracted a large crowd, including local media personnel. The girl even gave special poses when she realised the presence of the media taking her photos.

A mobile police vehicle (MPV) arrived shortly after receiving the call and brought her to the police station.
