Addict takes his toddler along for drug fix

A 27-YEAR-OLD drug addict allegedly brought his two-year-old daughter to get his "fix" in an estate in Baling district, Kedah, *Guang Ming Daily* reported.

The man was arrested by the National Anti-Drugs Agency during a raid on Monday.

It reported that the man, who was on his motorbike, claimed that he was taking his daughter sightseeing.

The man and eight other people arrested tested positive for drugs, it reported.

The authority informed the girl's family members who then took her home.

The video of the boy driving went viral on social media.

In the video, the man, who was on the driver's seat, had allowed the boy to sit on his lap and have full control of the steering wheel.

The voices of two women, with one of them reminding the boy to step on the brake and gas pedals, were clearly heard, too.

Police have revoked the driving licence of the man pending investigation.
