Engineering student, friend held over ganja

KUALA LUMPUR: A Nigerian studying engineering at a private university in Cheras was among two people picked up by police for suspected involvement in drug distribution.

The 27-year-old, who has been in Malaysia for three years, and his friend, aged 29, were detained behind a restaurant at Taman Melati in Wangsa Maju here on Dec 22 at 10.30pm. City police chief Datuk Mohd Salleh said police seized 15 slabs, believed to be ganja, and a packet of syabu from them. The duo, who were in a rented Perodua Myvi, were waiting for a buyer when they were arrested.
