

Four nabbed as cops bust drug depot at nursery

KUALA LUMPUR: A couple and the woman's mother have been detained by police for using their nursery as a front to distribute drugs to local syndicates.

A Bangladeshi worker was also detained during an operation which netted some RM300,000 worth of heroin.

City police chief Deputy Comm [Datuk Mohmad Salleh](#) said that acting on a tip-off, a police team raided the nursery in Jalan Hulu Langat, Batu 9, Cheras, at 3pm on Monday.

Police found 20 plastic packets of heroin, weighing about 9.1kg, in a bag.

"Initial investigations revealed that the suspects have been using the nursery to carry out drug transactions for the past few months.

"The suspects have been remanded until Monday to assist in investigations," DCP Mohmad said.

Police believe the suspects are linked to several syndicates active in supplying drugs in the Klang Valley.
