Four nabbed for suspected drug possession, abuse

MIRI: Four men were arrested by narcotics police on Saturday night on suspicion of drug possession and abuse.

The suspects, three of them aged 20 while another was a 22-year-old, were nabbed in a house in Desa Senadin around 10pm during a police raid.

Miri acting police chief Supt Stanley Jonathan Ringgit, when contacted yesterday, confirmed the arrest made.

"One of the suspects had resisted and was combative towards the police upon his arrest," said Stanley.

The suspects were brought to Miri central police station (CPS) to facilitate police investigations. The case is being investigated under Section 15(1) and Section 12(3) of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952.

During the raid, police also seized a smoking box set from the suspects which containing two packets of substance believed to be a banned drug (Syabu).

All suspects have tested positive for drug abuse.
