LUMUT: Two members of uniformed units were among 32 people detained by the National Anti-Drugs Agency (Nada) in Manjung and Pulau Pangkor during a two-day operation which ended yesterday.

Perak Nada director, Khairul Anwar Ahmad, said a 32-year-old Civil Defence Force (APM) member in full uniform was nabbed at about noon at a drug den in a goat pen in Sri Manjung here. He tested positive for methamphetamine.

Khairul said the other man is a Royal Malaysian Navy (RMN) personnel aged 31, who also tested positive for methamphetamine. -- BERNAMA
