Teenager nabbed for processing eramine

KUALA LUMPUR: A teenager who possessed Eramine 5 pills was nabbed at a traffic roadblock last night when his attempt to throw away the drugs 100-metre before the roadblock, caught the attention of the police.

Kuala Lumpur Traffic Special Enforcement Unit chief ASP Azmi Wahid said the teenager, who was riding a motorcycle, was seen throwing off something by the roadside before several policemen found two of the pills.

`Thus, we arrested him and after being questioned several times, only then did he confess that he had just taken the pills three weeks ago,` he told reporters during an operation dubbed 'Ops Samseng' here.

An inspection had also revealed that the teenager did not have a driving license and roadtax, and he was also tested positive for marijuana.

The operation began at 10.30pm and ended at 1.30am this morning alongside the Duta-Ulu Kelang Expressway (DUKE) exit to Padang Balang, Sentul and was participated by nine police personnel.

"About 180 vehicles were inspected whereby 317 summonses issued for various offences. Eight motorcycles had also been seized," he said. -- BERNAMA
