Whole family abuse drugs

KUCHING: Two girls aged 14 and 15 lodged a report against their mother at Simpang Tiga Police Station last Sunday evening.

They were referred to an investigating officer and checked. No signs of injuries were found on them.

The officer then got the girls' urine tested when they could not answer a few simple questions.

When the girls tested positive for syabu the police officer told their mother to come to the station.

The mother, a 32-year-old woman from a village in the outskits of the city reached the station around 11pm Sunday and her urine was tested too. The test proved positive for syabu as well as ketamine.

The police also found injection marks on the arms of the girls and their mother.

It was later learnt that the girls' father is still serving his time in jail for drug abuse.

The girls and their mother were all sent to Satok police station where they were locked up.
