## Woman caught with drugs in underwear

KUALA LUMPUR: A woman from Guinea, Africa, was arrested at the Kuala Lumpur International Airport with syabu worth RM270,000 found in her underwear and a secret compartment of her luggage on Monday.

Federal narcotics director Datuk Noor Rashid Ibrahim said the 30-year-old woman was picked out for inspection after she arrived on a flight from Cairo, Egypt.

"The authorities found her behaviour suspicious and decided to take her in for questioning," he said.

A body check was conducted and police found 500g of syabu in her panties. They checked her luggage and found more drugs in a secret compartment. The woman has been remanded.
